Library

Mrs Batty, the librarian, has asked that all students bring a cloth bag or a cloth shopping bag to protect the borrowed books when students are taking them home.

Absences

Thank you to the parents and carers who have called the school office, emailed the school or sent a written note explaining the reason/s for your child being away. Under the Department of Education, it is a legal requirement to provide an explanation to the school stating the reasons why your child was absent from school. If a student is absent on a regular basis, under Department of Education guidelines we are required to monitor the non-attendance, record it onto our data base and work with you to improve your child's attendance.

If your child returns to school and the class teacher or the school has not received a reason for your child's absence within a few days, the class teacher will send a reminder note (please view the sample below). Please give a detailed explanation on the reason why your child was away and return it with your child to give to their class teacher.

For Android users:

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
4. Click the "Install" button.
5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
6. Click "Open" when installed.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: Some brands of Android phones need the setting in "Notification Manager" changed to "Allow" instead of "Notify" in order for the push notifications to work. The phone must also be running at least version 4 system software to run the app.



For Windows 8.1 Phone and Windows 8.1 or 10 device users:

1. Go to the Windows Store on your 8.1 Windows Phone or Windows 8.1/10 Device
2. Search for "Skoolbag" in the keyword app search
3. Install the Skoolbag app
4. Find your school either by using the keyword search or location service.
5. Click the "Pin" icon to pin the school tile to your Windows Phone home screen.
6. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup"
7. Toggle the Push Categories that are applicable to you by tapping the on/off switch.

Please Note: The Skoolbag Windows App is for 8.1 version Windows Phones, or Windows 8.1 and 10 devices.



Parent Helpers in the classroom

If you would to assist in the classroom please contact the school and we will organise a time for you to do an Induction course and assist you fill in Working with Children Check forms. Some major projects that we require assistance in are: reading with students or implementing individual student programs.

Reminders

Confidential family matters and medical reports

If you have you have any confidential family matters that may impact on your child's wellbeing such as custody issues, family court orders and medical reports etc you need to see myself or if I am unavailable to see Ms Urry before seeing the class teacher. This way the school as a collective can best cater to you and your family's needs. At the same time, copies of relevant legal or

medical documents are required at the school so that we can follow the directions or recommendations. We will do everything to work with you and your child however, the school can only follow the directions from the courts or medical reports. Once again you are better to see me if there are complex issues and we can work on an action plan.

School uniforms

As a new school we are working towards establishing pride in Spring Farm Public. Research has stated that wearing full school uniform can assist in developing 'self esteem and a sense of connection to the community, more information about wearing the correct school uniform can be found on <https://www.det.nsw.edu.au/wellbeing/connect/school-uniforms>.

I do ask if you can source a navy blue jacket, navy sloppy joe, navy blue shorts and pants and school shirt as we are trying to instill pride, set a good example for our new enrolments and develop a connection with each other. If you require assistance in purchasing various uniform please contact the school and we will work something out. **If you have any spare uniforms please donate to the school and we can assist other families.**

Before and After school Care

The YMCA is currently organising Before and After School Care for Spring Farm Public School students. Please contact YMCA Narellan for further details.

You can also obtain an EOI survey to indicate your interest for a Before and After School Care program at Spring Farm Public School. Please email or phone the school for a hard copy which we can send with your child or come to the office and fill out the survey.

Signing in and dogs prohibited on school premises

Due to WHS requirement and Department of Education policy, it is a requirement to sign in as a visitor at the front office. If you need to deliver something to your child, pick them up early or need to send a message please contact the school office and we can assist in these matters.

Under the Companion Animals Act, 1998 No 87 (14.1.e), all dogs are prohibited in school grounds, (whether or not they are leashed or otherwise controlled). Thank you for understanding and support.

Driving on Barley Road Spring Farm

Please be mindful that new parking signs will be erected at any given time and **large fines will be issued. Please be mindful** on how fast you drive into Barley Rd off Spring Farm Rd as students and parents cross the road, thank you for your understanding.

Crunch and sip

This is a set break during class time to snack on fruit or vegetables. We encourage all students to bring a piece of fruit and a small bottle of water to enjoy during crunch and sip time. This snack time will allow students to refuel and stay hydrated throughout the day.
